### **Course Description**

The purpose of this course is to complement regular classroom language classes by providing students with individualized tutorial assistance so that the students will be able to integrate the four Chinese skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing through assisted and disciplined practice outside the classroom. Depending on the students' level of proficiency, the tutors may assist the students in strengthening any perceived weak areas of the students' Chinese language learning and/or the students may choose to use the tutors' help in completing any projects related to Chinese language learning, such as their oral interview project for the core course or any topic of their own interests, e.g. watching Chinese movies, reading Chinese newspapers, reading Chinese novels, etc.

### **Learning Objectives**

The students will receive the individualized help they need in learning Chinese and be able to use the Chinese language comfortably and confidently in the local community.

### **Course Prerequisites**

None

### **Methods of Instruction**

Meetings, discussions, and methods agreed among the tutors and the students under the supervision of the Resident Director.

### **Assessment and Final Grade**

Learning Profile: 80%

Final Presentation: 20% (5 minutes in Chinese)



**Course Requirements**

1. Regular tutorial sessions: a total of 15 hours (minimum) during the semester with each meeting to be recorded on each student’s Language Learning Profile (the “log sheet”).
2. Final Presentation: the students will share their study abroad experience by a public presentation with the presence of Chinese native speakers in the local community.
